A note from Corey . . .

Dear Sisters, do you feel chained in circumstances over which you have no control and feel as if you can't get free? When Paul was in Prison—literally “chained” by his circumstances, he urged the church in Colosse and all believers everywhere to devote themselves to prayer. (Col 4:2-4) “Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.” Let this be our focus: to pray for opportunities to proclaim the gospel message clearly by our actions and by our re-actions in these unique times so that we may bring glory to our Father in Heaven. We can do this if we don't struggle against our “chains” and, instead, lean into Him—that is what He's waiting for! Embrace sweet surrender and allow His peace to surpass understanding. Paul tells us in his last remarks (Col 4:18) “...Remember my chains. Grace be with you”.
